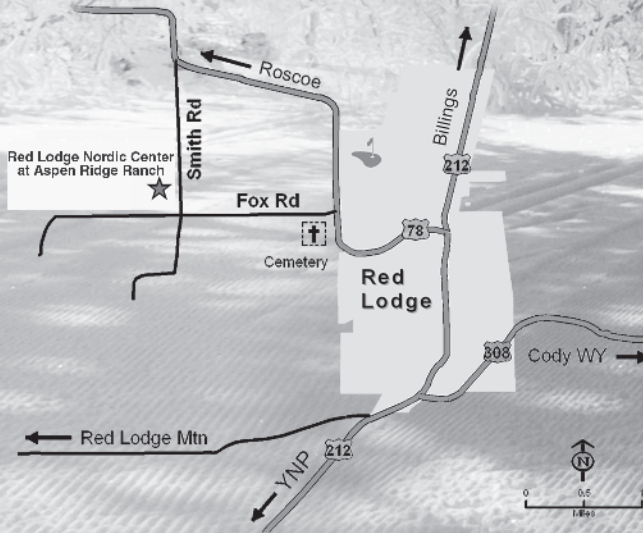

How To Get There Travel 1 mile northwest of Red Lodge on Highway 78 and turn left on Fox Road just after the cemetery. Proceed 1 mile to the intersection of Smith Road and turn right at the RLNC sign. Parking is available 1/4 mile on left side of Smith Road. Ski rentals available at Sylvan Peak in Red Lodge.

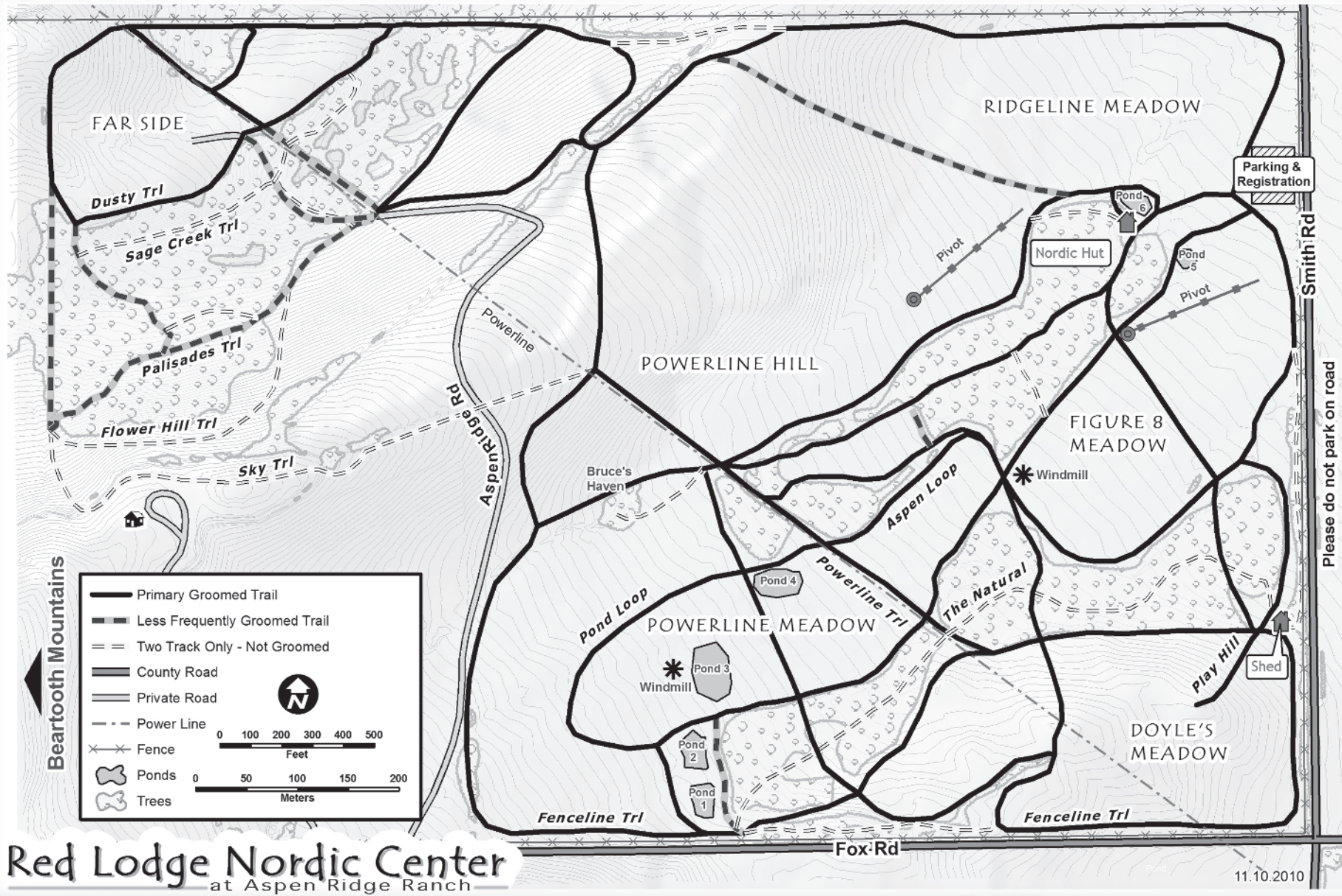
